



1 the drowned city of Reimerswaal where the ancestors of the Rosevelts came from.

2 The "Rosevelt" where the Rosevelts got there name from. Kadijk 22 should be the farm where the ancestor of. USA president Franklin Delano Roosevelt left for the USA around 1649.

3 Oud Vossemeer according to American Rosevelts the cradle . In the Ambachtssherenhuis the coat of arms of J.W. van 't Rosevelt, in the NH church several items and the Four Freedoms Monument.

4 In 1736 here a waterinlet was laid by J.W. Rosevelt and L. van Rosevelt, councillor and mayor of Oud Vossemeer.

5 The Battery with hollow road, as name suggests this was a fortified place with canons. From 1568-1648 during the 80 year War with Spain this side of the island Tholen was THE frontline!

6 According to literature this house Vrijberghe was in 1750 called "het Rozevelt". Possibly J.W. van 't Rosevelt lived here during the years he was amabachtsheer (lord) and Bailliff. (1733-1746)

7 In the NH church of Scherpenisse a similar chandelair can be found as in the NH church of Oud Vossemeer with inscription of J. v. Rosevelt

10 In Tholen lived a number of Rosevelts, Marinus and his wife are buried in the NH church of Tholen
